MEMBERSHIP

FEES

WORK PARTY

I have <u>ONE</u> work party planned for **Sunday 29th March 2009**, the work scope includes repairs to the track, New parking area on the back lake, cutting back some of the vegetation, opening new swims on the back lake and removal of a fallen tree in the front lake

THE REEDS

Unfortunately, some of the fish have previously been injured when snagged in the reeds on the back lake, consequently over the last 18 months I have been removing most of the long reeds that were taking over parts of the lake. In the process new swims have opened up giving access to areas which were previously unfishable. I have planted numerous lilies in between the swims to try and give the fish cover where the reeds had previously grown.

PLANTS WANTED

Most of the overhanging branches which were in the lake have been removed, but in order to create suitable fish cover areas we will need to plant these areas with lilies and reed beds (short length reeds). If any member has access lilies, reeds or water iris, or knows somebody who has some they want to get rid of please let me know.

BENCHES WANTED

As you have noticed, I put a garden bench in one of the swims on the front lake and would like to place a few more around the lakes. If anyone has any unwanted suitable timber or metal garden benches please let me know.

NEW TIMES

In order to keep good relations with local residents the access times are now changed to 6am till 10pm in the May-September and dawn till dusk in at other times of the year. Failure to comply will result in immediate expulsion..

WEBSITE

The club now has a website for members to exchange info etc.

ACCESS

The access tracks and pathways around the lake have been cleared to give vehicular access around the back lake, together with NEW parking areas, however there have been occasions when access around the lake has been prevented by members blocking the tracks & paths with their vehicles, brollies, bivies and tackle. Therefore it is **COMPULSORY** that the track & pathways be kept clear at **ALL** times and that cars are parked in designated car parking areas only. Remember that driving to the rear lake is only allowed in the **DRY SUMMER MONTHS ONLY**
